

Rehearsal Grading Policy - 6 Points Daily

Preparation (2 Points - 33%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Music - Your own - every class● Pencil - Your own- every class
Participation (2 Points - 33%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Be to class on time and ready to rehearse (participate in warm-ups, proper posture, music out, etc)● Sing/play appropriately (characteristic sound)● Listen to instruction/discussion when stopped
Effort (2 Points - 33%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Improve through rehearsal● Focus - Taking notes, participating in discussions, making connections● Behavior – On task, respectful, attentive

30 Points

- *Sitting/Standing with expected and appropriate posture*
- *Remaining focused between and during pieces (quiet/attention on director)*
- *Singing/playing correct part on correct pitches, in correct octave*
- *Your cell phone is not on your person*
